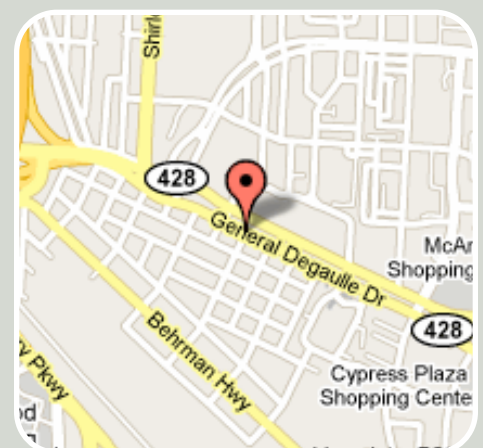

Cafe Rendezvous Restaurant

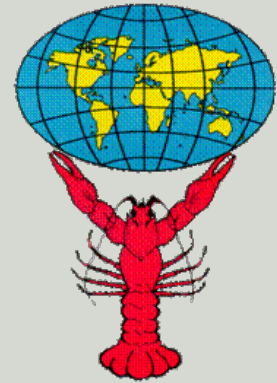
